The particular point of Submission 314 I support is:

Point 3.4 - Any rezoning of the area north of the Haast township would need to be undertaken in a way that is sensitive to the ongoing protection of the Haast airfield. Given that aviation activities, including helicopters and fixed wing aircraft, form part of the character and history of the area, these activities need to continue to be able to access this airfield and those further south. However, it is considered likely that any future residents would be aware of, and comfortable with, the aviation character of the area. The airfield is used sporadically and not generally late in the day. If the area around the airport is rezoned to accommodate future residential growth and displacement as a result of natural hazards, then a new rule could be included in the subdivision chapter requiring that future development is undertaken sensitively to airport activities, including no objection covenants and acoustic insulation.

The reasons for my support are:

Any change of land use or rezoning in the Haast area has the potential to affect operations at the Haast Airfield. I support Submission 314 as it seeks protection of aviation activities at the Haast Airfield.

Designating the airfield as AIRPZ (as per Submission 458) would provide this protection and avoid conflict associated with changing land use in the surrounding area.

I seek that the whole of Submission 314 be allowed:

Specifically, I request that the TTPP protect the Haast Airfield by designating it AIRPZ.
