I have attached three maps outlining opposition to the current Hazard/Flood area,s identified in pink that encapsulate the elevated terrace in the Baker Creek/Oparara district.

This needs to be modified to the flat river plain area,s only and NOT the elevated terrace plateau,s as drawn.

Given that the lowest height of the adjoining plateau is 4.5m above the entire Karamea/Market Cross flood plain at the highest datum point would demonstrate that the entire Karamea township would be completely under water !!!!

If further building or construction is to transpire in the area for future development/expansion then elevated land such as the Baker Creek and Oparara plateau,s will become the norm.


We all need to encourage growth and opportunity for small town internal rural economy status so from this I ask that you re-visit the original draft and alter accordingly
