Proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan Notified

After three years of development in consultation with iwi, the community and stakeholder groups, the Joint TTPP Committee has approved the Proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan for public notification on 14 July 2022.

The proposed TTPP provisions and maps have been updated following feedback we received on the Exposure Draft earlier this year. Not all the feedback resulted in changes being made. Have a look at the proposed TTPP and see what is new and what remained the same.

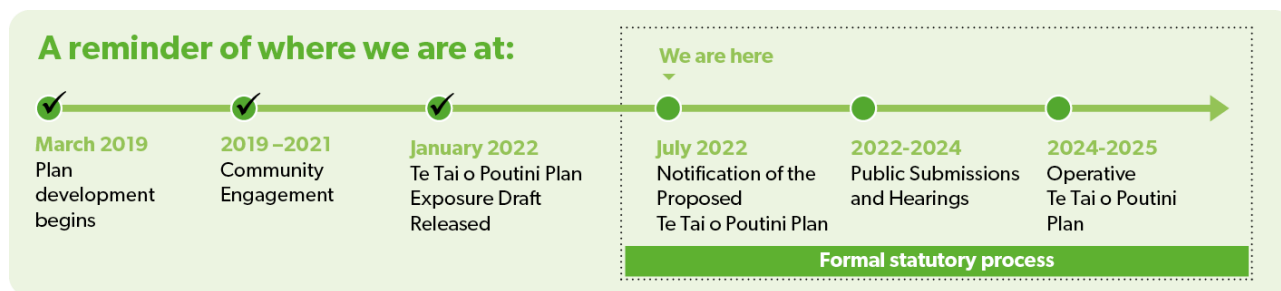
