I do not consent to the proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan (TPP) process as it is undemocratic.

I do not consent to the rules that have immediate legal effect that are identified in the proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan. There was no verbal face to face consultation with landowners on the legal effect.

As a private land holder of a scheduled site or area of significance to Maori I have not received a letter from the TTPP committee advising of this proposed TTPP.

A phone call was made to Jo at the council on the 29th July 2022 who advised that a letter would in the mail and still no letter has arrived.

I then attended a public meeting that was held of discussion on the proposed TTPP. At the meeting were told there were some errors with the mapping so there would be an extension for the submissions.
