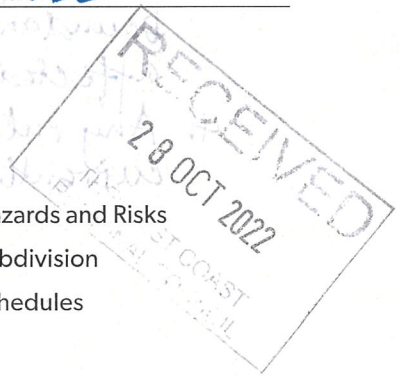

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My submission:

I wish to support my fellow residents on Main South Road, Gladstone in their OPPOSITION to the proposed boundaries for SASM68-Paroa Lagoon.

The proposed boundaries effectively place an encumbrance on many freehold properties on the eastern side of State Highway 6 (Main South Road). The planners have admitted that an error was made in transcribing the boundaries that requested by Poutini Ngai Tahu, but claim the error is too great to be corrected other than by the formal process of making a submission to the TPPP. I therefore support the four requested alterations, viz.:

1. That the eastern boundary of the designated SASM68 be amended and realigned to the Paroa Lagoon Waterway eastern edge.
2. That any proposed references, rules or conditions, placed on any private property fronting the State Highway be withdrawn immediately.
3. New large scale maps accurately showing this new boundary delineation be produced and supplied to all affected parties for approval.
4. Any rules with immediate effect be withdrawn from the currently affected private properties.
