			I OPPOSE the proposed zoning adjacent to the Westport Rifle Range on Pakahi Road. There needs to be a buffer zone of more than 300 meters from Pakahi Road.
			There needs to be NO building allowed only grazing. ie. in the paddock which has 110KVA Wpt-Waim Transpower transmission feeder.
			The permitted activity in the Buller District plan of a rifle range on Pakahi Road appears to have been negated by the TTPP plan.
			The shooting community of Buller and New Zealand use this sporting facility daily to train for international sport, local hobby shooting, hunting practice and even for military training exercises, ATC, as well as police training which is on a certificated range as approved by NZ police and range inspectors.
