

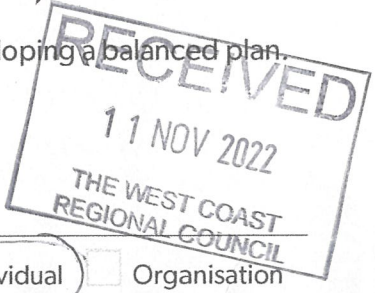

Buller Coalfield Zone & mineral Extraction Zones — I oppose this in the TTP Plan

- ① We don't need the district council plan to be having Coalfield + or mineral extraction zones. There is already a process for lawful mining.
- ② Both these zones appear to include some ^{pubk} conservation land — what authority does the council have to do that?
- ③ Re the Buller Coalfield zone, — promoting new mining activities there fails to recognise the special character of this area — there is wide spread agreement by ecologists and life scientists that the Dentiston + Stockton Plateau contains rare and unique plant and animal biodiversity, and spectacular land forms. The promotion of new mining activities fails to take this into account.

④ Although we need some coal for making steel. It can be sourced from other places that have lesser ecological values.

⑤ While more mining might bring short term economic gain — the damage to this special area is permanent.
