My submission:

I wish to make a submission against the large area of land between the Nelson Creek and the Redjacks Creek that has been included in the flood zone area.

I have a 41 hec block of land of terrace formation above the Nelson Creek Road to the south which is approximately 40 meters above the Nelson Creek.

A further 4 hec of terrace land on the ~~southern~~ ^{northern} side of Nelson Creek Road which is approximately 25 meters above Nelson Creek.

There is no way of either of these two areas ever being flooded and this large area between Nelson Creek and Redjacks creek needs to be looked at again.

It appears that no one has physically looked at this large area.

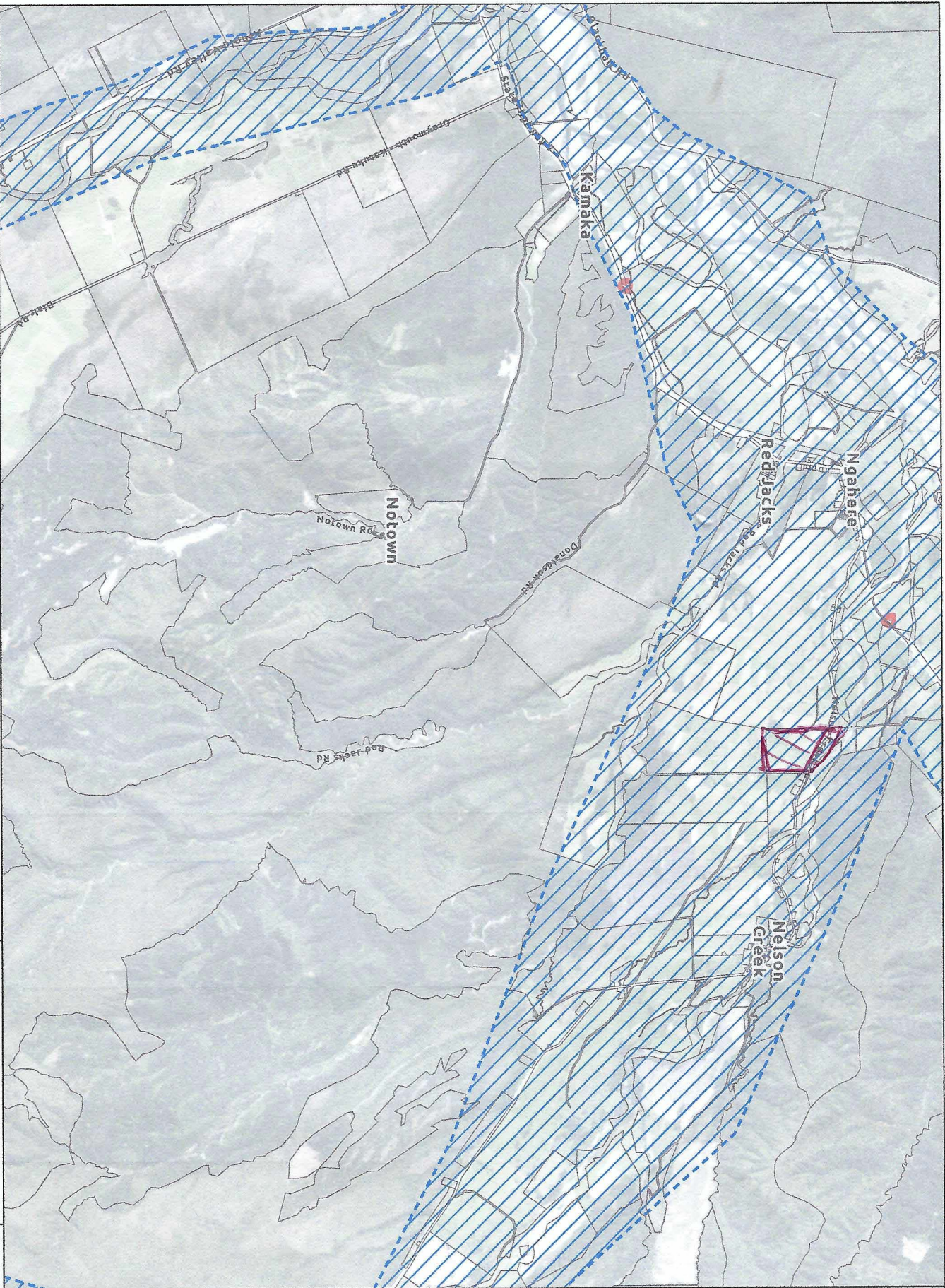
