My submission:

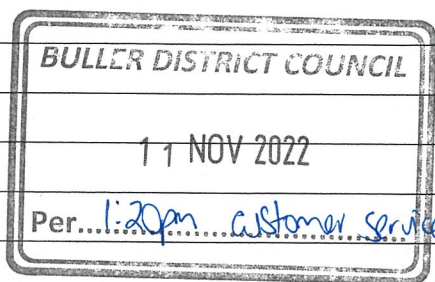

Coopers Drilling Services currently have a quarrying operation North of Westport at Jones Creek (Mining Permit MP60583) it currently supplies high demand and very high value aggregates including boulders (Diorite and Granite) for Coastal protection. I have also identified insitu Diorite adjacent to my mining permit and have applied for a prospecting permit with the intention of developing ^{this} extremely strategic resource.

I have a company that I am a 50% partner of called Papahua Resources Limited. My partner has submitted under Duncan Hardy.

Concerns My main concern is that if access to these mining and quarrying areas off the Papahua Ranges are put off limits then this will deny the Buller district of a essential resource.

It is essential that general rules for mineral extraction are included within the Papahua Ranges including the Buller coalfield zone.
