Submission for Coastwide Surveys

Coastal Hazard Severe Overlay in the vicinity of Greyhound Road - Arahura

We oppose the inclusion of a Coastal Severe Overlay in the vicinity of Greyhound Road, Arahura.

I have attached a map showing the Coastal Hazard Severe overlay, and a map showing the Coastal Hazard Severe and Coastal Hazard Alert overlays.

In the explanation of the Coastal Hazard Overlays in the proposed plan it states “Coastal Severe” where risk from coastal erosion and inundation have been modelled and mapped”.

In the Greyhound Road vicinity only inundation has been modelled and mapped.

We request that the Coastal Hazard Severe overlay be amended to Coastal Hazard Alert overlay, consistent with the surrounding area.

I have attached an email from Edith Bretherton, Senior Planner – Te Tai o Poutini Plan, confirming that the Coastal Severe overlay over Greyhound Road is an error, and that it should be Coastal Alert.
