My submission:

We oppose the proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan:
sites of significance to māori.

We don't believe there has been enough time for landowners to find out why their/our property has been identified as a site or area of significance to Māori. We are 'part' māori and don't believe our farmland should be included in the proposed plan.

Where is the information that has been identified which shows our land is a significant site/area?

We don't think we should be given 'rules' to obey for land we have 'looked after' and used as grazing agricultural land for donkey's years. The proposed plan could prevent us from continuing to 'look after' the land, for example weed and pest control, ~~water~~ rock maintenance to protect the land.

Also the power poles run through the land, will the proposed plan prevent/restrict maintenance.

The whole of New Zealand is a significant area for Māori, I/we don't believe you can pull 'pockets' of land out to label as significant.

This is a ~~waste~~ waste of ratepayers, tax payers money and should not be proposed. Therefore

we oppose the proposed TTPP sites and areas of significance to māori especially for our property which we maintain and use as a productive farming business.
