
Re: Heritage Sites & Recreation Opportunities

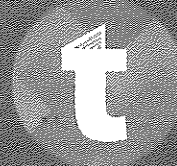
