MINUTE 13 – RESCHEDULED HEARING, ONLINE ONLY HEARING, LATE EVIDENCE

- 1. Due to ongoing illness of the technical expert related to the Noise topic, this hearing will no longer be commencing on the 13th February, and will be rescheduled to later in 2024. A new timetable for the release of s42A reports and filing of evidence will be provided in due course.
- 2. Following caucusing of planners for the Energy, Infrastructure and Transport hearing in the week beginning the 18th December 2023, this hearing will, depending on the outcome of the caucusing, be reconvened on the 13th and/or 14th of February 2024.
- 3. The Designation topic hearing which is scheduled to begin on 13 December 2023, will be online only, as no submitters wish to be heard.
- 4. It has come to our attention that pre-circulated evidence from Manawa Energy for the Historic Heritage topic, and from Waka Kotahi for the Designations topic was accidentally not publicly released at the time of filing by those parties. The only submitters likely to be affected were submissions in support and so were unlikely to have filed legal submissions in relation to the pre-circulated evidence.
