Hearing Panel SASM 120 Lyn McIntosh

Please present the following email to the hearing panel on my behalf and could you please confirm you have received this email.

I appreciate the opportunity to be involved in the process regarding the proposed Te Tai O Poutini Plan (TTPP). Sites and Areas of Significance to Maori. The specific part of the plan is: Part Two – District wide matters Te Wahanga 2 Nga Kaupapa a Rohe Whanui HCV Historical and Cultural Values Nga Uara a Ahurea, a Hitori Hoki SASM.

I oppose the inclusion of my property parcels in mapping and identifying SASM 120 in the plan.

According to a letter dated 5 October 2022 from the Chair of the Te Tai o Poutini Plan Committee, I was incorrectly advised that there was an Area of Significance to Maori (SASM) over my land parcels. This letter specifically lists my property parcels and specifically states that my property parcels are <u>not</u> located within a site or area of significance to Maori (SASM).

The letter explains that the actual area of significance was a nearby waterway. Please see attached copy of this letter.

Further, on the 9 November 2022 the WCRC contracted GIS analysis for the TTPP plan (The Property Group) confirmed that SASM 120 was a waterway specific site. This email is attached.

I was advised in November 2022, by the West Coast Regional Council Planner Ms Armstrong, that the map for SASM 120 would be amended and my property land parcels removed from the SASM 120 map. I understand that there has been an administrative oversight and removing SASM 120 from over my land has not happened.

I believe that the Te Tai O Poutini Plan map should accurately reflect SASM 120 being a waterway specific site by excluding my private land from SASM 120 map. This would avoid confusion and give a clear and accurate representation of SASM 120.

Attached relevant information:


- 1. 9th November 2022, email from GIS analyst stating the SASM 120 is a waterway specific site.
- 2. 5th October 2022, letter from Rex Williams, Chair Te Tai o Poutini Plan Committee. This letter confirms that my property is not located within a SASM under the proposed TTPP Plan. Mr Williams advised any questions regarding this to phone the TTPP Council Planners. I did this and was advised that the SASM was being taken off my land and amendments would be made along with other land owners that had SASM incorrectly put over their land. It now appears there's been an oversight and my land was not corrected.

3. Two maps that show that the SASM is still part over one block of land and fully over another.




However, with SASM 120, this is a waterway specific site, with the following advice applying to this specific SASM:

'This site of significance to Māori (Poutini Ngāi Tahu) is a waterway. Any private property land parcels within or beside this identified water have no 'Site or Area of Significance to Māori' rule restrictions that apply to them.'

This will also be applicable to the advice that Jo provided to Lynette regarding the northern block, as there are a few meters of SASM 120 within this property too, however again it will only apply to the waterbody.

Correction to letter: Site or Area of Significance to Māori in the Proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan

This letter confirms that your property at LOT 2 DP 308 LOT 2 DP 2426 LOTS 1-3 DP 9 62 PT RES 146 LOT 3 DP 423 RS 4731 SECS 26-31 SO 12249 and 2577027402 is **not** located within a Site or Area of Significance to Māori (SASM) under the proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan (TTPP).

The TTPP Committee apologise for incorrectly sending you a letter on 14 July 2022 advising that a site or area of significance had been identified on your land parcel. The actual area of significance identified by Poutini Ngāi Tahu was a nearby waterway. Enclosed is a map which identifies the location of a waterway of significance to Poutini Ngāi Tahu in relation to your property. We can confirm that in relation to this waterway site, there are <u>no</u> sites or areas of significance to Māori rule restrictions that apply to the land parcels beside this identified waterway.
