Master-Planning Exercise

INTRODUCTION

- 1. During the recent Residential and Rural hearing submitters raised in evidence and in response to our questions, the Master-Planning exercise currently being undertaken as part of the Resilient Westport project. Up until this point the Hearing Panel had been unaware of this exercise.
- 2. The Hearing Panel acknowledges that this Master-Planning exercise is a separate process from the Proposed Te Tai O Poutini Plan process however given the level of rezoning requests in the Westport area there is a reasonable degree of overlap.
- 3. Pursuant to section 41C (4) of the RMA the Hearing Panel requests that the Resilient Westport Master-Planning team provide information on the Master-Planning process and attend a hearing so as to inform the Hearing Panel of links, if any, with rezoning requests it is currently dealing with.
- 4. As a result of recent changes in our hearing schedule we consider the morning of the 20th of November 2024 could be made available to hear from the Master-Planning team at Westport. A time and location will be advised in due course.
- 5. Pursuant to section 42A(3)(b) of the RMA we require the information be provided to the Hearing Panel by the 12th of November 2024, being five working days before the hearing.
