Response to Commissioners Question re Objective – O1(2)

- 1.0 The Commissioners at the hearing in relation to noise, of 5th September 2024, requested that I review the now recommended wording in relation to *O1* of the signs chapter with respect to the word "*proposed*".
- 1.1 In providing these comments I note that I did not submit evidence in regard to the matter.
- 1.2 In responding to this matter I have referred to Appendix 1 of the s42A Report as, following the recommendation to "accept" the submission of Westpower, I understand that sets out the wording of O1 as now proposed, ie "2. Ensuring that <u>any proposed</u> signage is compatible with the ...".
- 1.3 I accept the recommendation as it adopts the outcome sought through the Westpower submission in regard to management of effects of *proposed signage*.
- 1.4 I note that *Policy* 2 as recommended includes the management of *cumulative effects* which would include, when considering any proposed signage, recognition of any existing signage.
