**MINUTE 43 – UPDATED INFORMATION ON  
NATURAL HAZARDS**

## INTRODUCTION

1. The Hearing Panel was recently made aware that a report prepared by GNS Science dated July 2022 and entitled *Updated Alpine Fault mapping and Fault Avoidance Zones for priority areas in the West Coast region* has not been available to submitters on the Te Tai o Poutini Plan (TTPP) website, but has been referred to in the Section 42A Officer's Report on Natural Hazards - Ngā Mōreareatanga Aotūroa.
2. It is understood that the reference to the report is in Section 7.3 Earthquake Hazard Overlays of the Section 42A report and relates in particular to the following submitters and further submitters:
