# Memorandum

Re: Mineral Extraction Zone 13: Echo

### 1.0 Notified MINZ




Figure 1: Notified MINZ at Echo.

A map of the notified Mineral Extraction Zone (MINZ) at Echo is included in Figure 1 below and attached in Appendix 1.

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#### 2.0 Submissions

No submissions were received in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 3.0 Evidence

No evidence was received in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.0 Assessment of Information Provided by Council

Information has been provided by Buller District Council and the West Coast Regional Council. The following resource consents were identified as relative to the notified MINZ at Echo (**Figure 1** above).

#### 4.1 West Coast Regional Council

#### 4.1.1 RC09035

This resource consent grants a Land Use Consent to undertake land disturbance, vegetation removal and earthworks associated with an opencast coal mine on Mineral Permit (MP) 41269 and MP 41685. Condition 1.4 of the resource consent specifies that the consent holder shall carry out earthworks associated with mining activities inside the areas within the red and blue lines and labelled "41269 and 41685" on the attached map titled "Access Arrangement MP 41-269 and MP 41-685" (Appendix 2) and inside the area shaded in red titled "AA Variation application area" on the attached aerial titled "Annexure 2: RC09035v1 area extension" (Appendix 3). This resource consent commenced on 01 February 2010, with the variation dated 12 January 2011, and has a duration of 35 years from the date of issue. See Figure 2 below for an approximation of the subject site (original area outlined in light blue and variation area outlined in pink) in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.1.2 RC09120




Figure 2: Map of Authorised Mining Activities in relation to MINZ. The full map at Appendix 12.

This resource consent grants three Land Use Consents and one Water Permit associated with an opencast coal mine within the area covered by MP 41269. The map provided with RC09120 is an aerial map from the Annual Work Programme prepared for 2018-2019 and outlines the "Access Arrangement MP41269 Boundary" (Appendix 4). This resource consent commenced on 01 February 2010 and has a duration of 35 years from the date of commencement. See Figure 2 below for an approximation of the subject site (outlined in dark blue) in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.1.3 RC09108

This resource consent grants a Land Use Consent to undertake land disturbance, vegetation removal and earthworks associated with an opencast coal mine within MP 41269 and MP 41685. The map provided with the RC09108 is an aerial map from the from the Annual work programme prepared 2020-2021 (Appendix 5). The map provided has no key to identify the "consented area" however it has a yellow outlined area which is the same as the "Access Arrangement" area mapped under RC09120 (above). This resource consent commenced on 1 February 2010 and has a duration of 35



years from the date of commencement. It is considered that the consented are under RC09108 is the same as that of RC09120 which is outlined in dark blue in **Figure 2** below.

#### 4.2 Buller District Council

#### 4.2.1 RC09/52

This resource consent grants the continuation of an existing opencast coal mining operation at Echo Mine near Reefton within MP 41269 and MP 41685. This decision was granted on 29 October 2009. Further information was supplied by Buller District Council which included the relevant plans for RC09/52 which showed the Department of Conservation Access Arrangement boundary within MP 41269 and MP 41685 (Appendix 6). It is determined that the consented area under RC09/52 is the same area that is also consented under RC09035 (discussed above) and outlined in light blue in Figure 2 below.

#### 4.2.2 RC09/68

This resource consent grants the consent holder the right to enable the expansion of mining operations at Echo Mine near Reefton. This consent was applied for the proposed expansion of mining operations into Wellman North. The consent holder sought and obtained land use consents to authorise the existing mine operations (via RC09/52) and submitted this consent application to cover expansion into Wellman North. This decision was granted on 19 December 2009. Further information was supplied by Buller District Council that included the relevant plans for RC09/68 which identified the approximate location of the proposed mine expansion into Wellman North (Appendix 7).

A variation decision, RC09/68a, was consented after the original approval to expand into Wellman North. This variation decision extended the expansion of the site further and included the new approved plan titled "Proposed Haul Road, Wellman North, Figure 1: Site Plan" (Appendix 8). See Figure 2 below for an approximation of the full expanded area for mining operations (outlined in green) in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.2.3 RC09/54

This resource consent grants the consent holder the right to enable the expansion of mining operations at Echo Mine near Reefton. This consent was applied for the proposed expansion of mining operations into Echo East Pit Stage 2. The consent holder sought and obtained land use consents to authorise the existing mine operations (via RC09/52) and submitted this consent application to cover expansions into Echo East Pit Stage 2. This decision was granted on 17 December 2009. Further information was supplied by Buller District Council which included the relevant plans for RC09/54 which included an aerial photograph showing the existing mine layout (under RC09/52) and the approximate location of the proposed mine expansion into Echo East Pit Stage 2 (Appendix 9).

A number variation decisions were consented after the original approval to expand into Echo East Pit. These variation decisions are identified as RC09/54a - RC09/54e and they authorised further incremental extensions to the Access Arrangement Area. The most recent sites plans were included with RC09/54d (Appendix 10) which show the most up to date representation of the Access Arrangement Area. See Figure 2 below for an approximation of the subject site expansion areas (outlined in yellow) in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.3 Schedule 9 proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan

Schedule 9 of the proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan identified lawfully established mineral extraction and processing areas by listing the authorisation mechanism that permitted the activity. Schedule 9 identified the following Resource Consents and Coal Mining License (CML) in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo:

- o RC09/52: Provided by Council and assessed above.
- o RC09/54: Provided by Council and assessed above.
- o RC09/68: Provided by Council and assessed above.
- o RC100087: This was provided by Buller District Council at further request. The approved plan is an aerial photograph titled "Plan E" and is the same plan that was attached to RC09035 (Appendix 3) and approved the variation extension. Therefore, it is determined that the consented area under RC100087 is the same as the expanded consented area under the RC09035 which is outlined in pink in Figure 2 below. The decision was granted on 22 December 2010.
- o RC110005: This was provided by Buller District Council at further request. The approved plan is titled "Proposed Haul Road, Wellman North, Figure 1: Site Plan" and is the same plan that was attached to RC09/68a (discussed above and provided at Appendix 8). Therefore, it is determined that the consented area under RC1110005 is within the expanded consented area under the RC09/68 which is outlined in green in Figure 2 below. The decision was granted on 08 March 2011
- o RC110057: This was provided by Buller District Council at further request. The approved plan is titled "Figure 1: Location of Proposed Wellman Overburden Stack Extension" and is the same plan that was attached to RC09/54b and formed a part of the expansion into Echo East Pit. Therefore, it is determined that the consented area under RC110057 is within the expanded consented area under RC09/54 which is outlined in yellow in Figure 2 below. The decision was granted on 09 August 2011.
- o RC120053: This was provided by Buller District Council at further request. The approved plan is titled "Figure 2: Site Plan" and is the same plan that was attached to RC09/54c and formed a part of the expansion into Echo East Pit. Therefore, it is determined that the consented area under RC110057 is within the expanded consented area under RC09/54 which is outlined in yellow in Figure 2 below. The decision was granted on 09 August 2012.
- o RC120096: This was provided by Buller District Council at further request. The approved plan is titled "Figure 2: Proposed Site Plan" and is the same plan that was attached to RC09/54d (Appendix 10). Therefore, it is determined that the consented area under RC120096 is within the expanded consented area under RC09/54 which is outlined in yellow in Figure 2 below.
- o CML37160: West Coast Regional Council have advised that they were not able to locate copies of the CML documents or maps as they are relatively old and not in the electronic filing system. They advised that New Zealand Petroleum and Minerals (NZPM) may hold a copy. A search on the NZPM GIS database for Mineral Permits shows that CML37160 is currently active as a Mining



Licence which commenced on 01 April 1987 and has an expiry of 31 March 2027<sup>1</sup>. It is currently owned by Birchfield Coal Mines Limited. Aerial imagery obtained from the NZPM GIS database for Mineral Permits showing the area encompassed by CLM37160 is provided as **Appendix 11**. See **Figure 2** below for an approximation of the subject site with the CML outlined in orange in relation to the notified MINZ at Echo.

#### 4.4 Summary

Based on an assessment of the available information, the resource consents provided and CML information sourced from NZPM confirm that a portion of the notified MINZ at Echo has authorisation to operate a mining activity (**Figure 2** below). A full copy of the map depicting the sites with authorisation to operate a mining activity in relation to MINZ at Echo is provided at **Appendix 12**.

#### 5.0 Recommendation


The additional information provided by the resource consents and CML listed above identify areas within the notified MINZ at Echo that have authorisation to operate a mining activity.

As we have not received a copy of a current Coal Mining Licence, Ancillary Coal Mining Licence or resource consent to confirm that the remaining land within the notified MINZ at Echo has been authorised to operate a mining activity, the following recommendation is made.

It is recommended that the notified MINZ for Echo is <u>reduced</u>, as outlined at **Figure 2** above and **Appendix 12**, to only include the areas subject to the existing resource consents and CML provided and discussed above.



RC09035 Original Map






RC09035 Variation Map




Annexure 2: RC09035v1 area extension











Figure 3: WELLMAN NORTH - PROPOSED MINING OPERATIONS




Figure 2: Aerial photograph showing the existing mine layout (February 2009) and the approximate location of the proposed mine expansion at Echo East Pit Stage 2. The black lines are the boundaries of mining permit areas.
