

## NOISE

### Response to MINUTE 59 – Noise Hearing

1. Jet Boating New Zealand (JBNZ) has submitted on rule NOISE-R2, and please refer to the submissions referenced S161.004 and S161.005.
2. JBNZ has followed the Review process concerning the NOISE chapter and has particularly reviewed the Reporting Officers s42A report and Addendum reports.
3. JBNZ supports the recommendations provided in the Reporting Officers s42A report Addendum #2 as follows.
  - a. Retain noise exemption 13 that refers to non-commercial motorised watercraft operating on the surface of waterbodies.
  - b. Amend noise exemption 17 that refers to noise from temporary activities. For completeness the amendment supported is as follows

The noise is from a Temporary Activity where the temporary activity occurs between 7:00am and 10:00pm, and no more than 12 days per calendar year<sup>42</sup> only<sup>43</sup>, and if operating outside of these hours complies with the underlying noise standards of the zone. This does not include any amplified noise.<sup>44</sup>

4. JBNZ will be happy to discuss this with the Hearing Panel if required.
