The Hazard Zone designations already in effect for Westport were rushed upon us while we suffered post flood trauma. This 2021 flooding was of an unprecedented nature, with the most widespread flooding coming from the Orowaiti River caused largely by the neglectful collapse of a major protection wall on the Buller and exacerbated by gravel build-up. Our Councils had received warning of this years before. Nothing was done. Other man made factors also exacerbated this inundation of our town.

All this has taught me that our Councils are not focused upon managing the beautiful assets of our coastal settlements. Townships that had been managed, protected, cared for and maintained throughout many generations.

Instead Climate Blame has become the catchall for negligence, empire building, wasteful spending, pipe dreams and ridiculous time wasting pseudo-inclusion such as we have suffered from this highly faulty and disrespectful submissions process.
