Subdivision Objectives		
SUB – O2	Subdivision occurs in locations and at a rate that:	
	a.	Is supported by the capacity of existing infrastructure networks, or provides for infrastructure facilities and networks that are sufficient to accommodate growth and development that meets the standards required by the Council and the Plan;
	b.	Facilitates the operation of critical infrastructure;
	c. Enables access and connectivity;	
	d.	Provide for the health, wellbeing and safety of the West Coast/Te Tai o Poutini community;
	e.	Provides for growth and expansion of West Coast/Te Tai o Poutini setttlements and businesses; and
	f.	Avoids significant natural hazards and are built to be resilient to natural hazards.

Subdivision Policies		
SUB - P4	Manage significant risks from natural hazards by restricting avoiding ¹ subdivision that:	
	a. Creates new or exacerbates existing natural hazards including coastal hazards, erosion, slippage, subsidence, falling debris, fault rupture, severe ground shaking or flooding; or	
	b. Results in adverse effects on the stability of land and buildings; and	
	c. Does not provide safe , flood free ² and stable building platforms at the time of subdivision.	
SUB - P6	Avoid subdivision:	
	a. In the RURZ - Rural Zones that could result in the creation of an unplanned new settlement;
