The actual Homestead is established on a raised section of the block nullifying any water / flood issues .

The only time / reason we would have an issue, is the fact that the Waimea is unfortunately very much silted up and this is due solely to the <u>Mining operations</u> <u>upstream</u>.No

Significant movement of water in times of downpour and heavy rain is not noticeably evident, this includes at the point where the Waimea meets the Sea .

This is in fact something that must be dealt with rather than pushing all resources into the Variation (2), Plan.

Case in point, is the recent fines Westland Regional Council imposed on an Operator for unlawful discharge in the Streams .( German Gulley / Waimea .)

## Please take this e-mail as our submission being, totally against and vehemently opposing Variation 2 to the proposed Te Tai Poutini Plan.
