We are totally opposed to Variation 2 proposal in TPP.

We are concerned that we did not receive any notification on this variation from TPP. We borrowed our neighbours letter and found this to be lacking in relevant information and no submission form supplied. We have had to attend meetings to understand the relevance of the changes

Computer mapping does not allow for easy interpretation

There has been no reliable data collected to support this proposal.

Some 20 years ago there was a public meeting at Carter's Beach Hall with a NIWA spokesperson talking on Coast Erosion. His advice was to shift the hall immediately before it washed away. The hall still operates on the same site.

We have lived on this property for 50+ years with nil effect from flooding, cyclones, tsunami or earthquakes

We also have concerns over the effectiveness of LIDAR mapping, it appears to be very generalist over all properties. Surely each property will differ in their location, height etc.

This variation will affect property land values, will our rates be adjusted accordingly?

we are totally opposed to TTR Variation 2:

Coastal Hazards mapping

- It has been a very undemocratic process
- Residents received mail adorned with Tetia O'Leary (was this to do with Greymouth's polytech?)
- It did not come with any explanation nor written in layman's terms
- We were unable to understand the contents
- Since then there has been minimal consultation
- We have submitted an variation 2 to proposed TTR Coastal Hazards mapping - restricted to only LAR mapping
- Other issues were addressed by some residents which were heard by the commissioners. This now allowing submitters to resubmit on TTR plan.

- TTR is based on a process of high end speculative modelling. There is no data, measurements or credible evidence available to support sea level rise, erosion or accretion.
- The buoy placed at Westport coast to measure currents has been destroyed - no data is collected.

- We do not support Managed Retreat, rate payers have not been asked if they support / or not managed retreat. A few people were polled - possibly from a resilient westport group going a high percentage for this
- Again another undemocratic process
