

APPEAL POINT TO BE WITHDRAWN

ENV-2025-CHC-000100

Buller Conservation Group has appealed ENV-2025-CHC-000100; Te Tai Poutini Plan

Buller Conservation Group (BCG) has liaised with the Te Tai Poutini Plan Committee concerning an appeal point allocated to the TTPP draft topic, 'Introduction and General provisions'.

The appeal point concerns the TTPP Contents page. BCG wants the Contents page reinstated in the adobe document 'Decision' version, whereas it has been eliminated. BCG also wanted a Contents page in the online version.

TTPP has just informed BCG that there will now not be an adobe document version of the plan. Much as BCG opposes this elimination, BCG must accept that this is a decision above what BCG can appeal. It was also explained to BCG that the format of the online version does not require a Contents page as the chapter headings are set up in the left-hand column of the TTPP website.

Therefore BCG withdraws the appeal point requesting a 'Contents' page in the adobe document 'Decision' version of the TTPP and a Contents page in the online version.
