Subject: ENV-2025-CHC-000100 Currie and others v Te Tai o Poutini Plan Committee

Kia ora,

I have referred the memorandum of New Zealand Coal and Carbon Ltd dated 20 April 2026 to Judge Reid who *responds*;

The court notes the withdrawal of the appeal points with the exceptions of

- i. Maps, SEC 39 SO11207 TWN OF ROA BLK II MAWHERANUI SD (Valuation ID 2543020700) and SEC 48 SO 11207 BLK II MAWHERANUI SD: the relief sought is an amendment (reduction) to the Settlement Zone at Roa township so it does not overlap with the MINZ and the Roa Mine access road and/or yard area.*
- ii. Schedule 4, Significant Natural Areas, BLA-P002 Mt Davy: the relief sought is the removal of the Roa Mining Company Ltd mining permits and licence from BLA-P002 Mt Davy.*
- iii. NOSZ - R18: the relief sought is to change the activity status from non-complying to discretionary.*
- iv. ECO - R10 4.a.: the relief sought is to amend this provision, so it is consistent with the December 2025 amendments to the National Policy Statement for Indigenous Biodiversity.*

Counsel for the TTPP is to advise whether the withdrawal creates any uncertainty as to which topics the appellant is still involved with. The parties will then have until Thursday 23 April 2026 to advise of any issues as to costs. If nothing is received the court will assume there are no issues.
