ENV-2025-CHC-000100 Currie v Te Tai o Poutini Plan Committee

My Submission although late, I believe has standing and is not invalid.

My submission was sent to the ttp committee on the 21st of November 2024 with a clear explanation of why it was late and a very detailed explanation of the problems that I had found that did not meet the overall objectives in the plan.

The explanation for the lateness of the submission was my seeking a waiver to file the submission out of time and have it considered by the ttp committee.
To me this was clearly accepted when I was issued and received a submission number (S764) on the 27th of November 2024.

My appeal on the 21st of November 2025 against the ttp decision to strike out my submission was because I considered that the ttp had accepted my submission on the 27 November 2024 and were now renegeing on that decision.

When the details of my submission are analysed, I believe that my submission is not frivolous and or vexatious. But because of the problems and errors I have uncovered regarding meeting the objectives it is reasonable and relevant to the proceedings.

I ask that the Environment Court allow my submission to stand.
