We understand that these appeals have been allocated to the mediation topics identified above, and we include that information to assist the Committee and the Court in updating their records.

BDC remains an appellant and/or section 274 party in other appeals allocated to a number of these same mediation topics. Accordingly, this withdrawal relates only to the appeals identified above and does not affect BDC's continued participation in any other appeals.

Given these appeals remain at the mediation stage, BDC does not consider that any issue as to costs arises. However, should any party raise a question of costs in relation to these withdrawals, BDC reserves its right to be heard.

Please advise counsel if the Registry or Court requires a memorandum of counsel or formal notice to withdraw BDC's interests, and we will arrange one to be filed. Otherwise, we would be grateful if you could please update the Court's records accordingly.
